


What degree program are you pursuing now?






How well were the teachers able to communicate?










The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.
















What percentage of teachers use ICT Tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.

STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY ON OVERALL INSTITUTIONAL PERFORMANCE RESULTS AND ANYLISIS

- I. Preamble:- The college had conducted survey on students' feedback on teaching methodology and effectiveness.
- II. Objective:- The objective was to find out the students' perception, views and suggestions with respect to the teaching being imparted at the institution.
- III. Timeline:- The survey was conducted at the end of the odd semester of academic year 2021-22 during the 1st week of March.
- IV. Participants:- Students of B A and B.COM Programmes of our institution; 233 students participated in the survey.
- **V. Mode and Instrument of Survey:-** The survey was conducted online by sending a structured questionnaire containing multiple choice questions to the e-mail accounts of the students and collecting the filled- response sheet from them.
- VI. The questions covered the following areas:
 - a. Demographic profile of the respondents.
 - b. Students views on teaching methodology and effectiveness.
- VII. Inference:- From the data collected with respect to
 - a. Demographic profile of the respondents, it was noted that
 - i) All the 233 respondents who are female students, this being so as the this is a women's college.
 - ii) All the respondents were pursuing Bachelors degree programmes.
 - iii) Majority of the respondents (61.2%) were found pursuing commerce while the remaining (38.4%) were pursuing Arts stream.
- VIII. b. Students' views on teaching methodology and effectiveness, it was observed that:-
 - 1) 98.3% of the respondents have confirmed that the syllabus coverage was to the extent of 85-100% While a small section of the respondents (1.7%) have indicated lesser coverage of syllabus.

- 2) Most of the students (94%) have found that, teachers were found to come thoroughly prepared for the classes.
- 3) Most of the respondents (94%) have opined that, their teachers were able to communicate effectively at all times.
- 4) Majority of the respondents (94%) have stated that, their teachers' approach to teaching was excellent.
- 5) Most of the respondents (95.3%) have found the internal evaluation by the teachers always fair.
- 6) Almost all of the students (96.1%) have confirmed that, their teachers every time discussed with them with respect to their (students) performance in assignments.
- 7) Majority of the students (85%) responded that, the institute regularly took active interest in Promoting internship, student exchange and field visit opportunities for students.
- 8) Almost all students (96.1%) have observed that the teaching and mentoring process in the Institution had been facilitating significantly their cognitive, social and emotional growth.
- 9) Majority of the students (87.6%) have agreed that the institution provided multiple Opportunities to the students to learn and grow.
- 10) almost all students (96.6%) have confirmed that the students sensitized them about the course and programme outcomes as well as the competencies they would acquire from the given courses / programme.
- 11) Majority of the students (95.7%) have stated that their mentor always followed up with them with respect to a task assigned to them.
- 12) Almost all students (96.1%) have found their teachers illustrating the concepts every time through example and applications.
- 13) Most of the students (95.3%) have stated that their teachers fully identified their strength and encouraged them by assigning appropriate challenges and tasks.
- 14) Similarly almost all students (96.6%) have found their teachers being able to identify their weaknesses and help them to overcome the same.

- 15) Majority of the students (87.1%) have confirmed that, they were being engaged by the institution in different aspects of Teaching -learning process (monitoring, review and quality improvement)
- 16) Majority of the students (85%) have responded that, the institute and the teachers using student centric methods to a great extent for enhancing their learning experiences.
- 17) Most of the students (90.1%) have strongly agreed that, their teachers encouraged them to take part in extra- curricular activities.
- 18) Most of the students (93.6%) have confirmed that, the institute teachers made efforts to a great extent to develop soft skills, life skills, the employability skills in them.
- 19) Majority of the students (88%) have stated that more than 90% of the teachers used ICT, tools while teaching.

To conclude, as seen in the above analysis and interpretation of the data collected under the survey, it is observed that, most of the students of this institution have strongly agreed and confirmed that, the overall quality of teaching and learning process in this institution was very good.

Still the survey has highlighted few suggestions made by the respondents to improve the overall teaching- learning experience like more interactive sessions, ICT facilities and certificate and add on courses as well as educational tour, field work and project work could be provided for.
