1. Introduction:

KNMNC – Library and Information Centre at the KNMNC came into exixtence in 1965. In the year 2005, the Library was shifted to the Independent Library building inaugurated by then Vice chancellor of Kuvempu University, Dr.K.Chidananda Gowda. In the midst of its excellent setup of academic activites, the Library acts as a nerve center catering to the needs of the students. Research Scholars and faculty members of the commerce and management and Arts and other humanities departments use it efficiently. The KNMNC Library has been shaped as a center of excllence for academic and research pursuits, keeping it open to the change brought about by information technology. Today the Library is housed in an independent building.

To fulfill the vision and mission of our institution, the beautiful library was established with an initial collection of 912 books and now it is rich with more than 35823 and unique titles of 18406. To broaden and enrich the students' quality of gaining relevant knowledge, our library is providing more than 51 regional and national journals in specific areas. To reach the student's requirements through providing formal and E-Resources, our institution has invested approximately 1 lakh rupees. To support in gaining specific services in the library, we have 03 different levels of trained and interested The college library has a ground floor building consists of the Circulation Section, Librarian's Chamber and Digital Library. Library has a reference section with a seating capacity of about 100 readers.

Here the students can refer to the latest books and old question papers. Students or staff can have access to a number of dailies, journals, professional, academic and general magazines. A wall magazine is being brought out through which students can exhibit their talents by writing some articles and cartoons etc.

The library is completely automated with the open source e-Lib software. It facilitates to staff to perform all library routine works like cataloguing, circulation, serial control, report generating, patron registration and generating the barcode for books through the software. Besides, it provides Online Public Access Catalogue

(OPAC) facility to students through online mode. In the view of providing right information to students, users can search the books, and give the purchase suggestion and know about issue of number of books to their account and get information about reading history of books for one year through OPAC.

- Question paper set, periodicals, reference books are not allowed to carry out of the library.


6. Library Collections:


13. Computerized Library Catalogue:

This helps the readers to know what books are available in the library a) of a given author, b)of a given subjects, c) of a given title etc...with the computer application to the library operations, the database of books is prepared and barcoded according to "e-lib **software**". The users can search the computerized database OPAC or the traditional catalog cards are arranged subject wise/Authors wise to known what information sources are available in the library in the areas of their interest.
